FIZ is a women right's organisation supporting refugee women, who experienced for example domestic or sexual violence, human trafficking, or forced marriage.

Do you have questions like

They gave me a Duldung.

What does that mean?

What can I do when my asylum case was rejected?

They asked me to bring a passport.

What does that mean?

We help answer questions concerning the asylum procedure, Duldung or a negative asylum decision. We help you consider perspectives for your situation.

You can come regardless of whether you are still in asylum procedure, your asylum case has been already rejected or you do not have any papers.

Our counselling services are free and anonymous.
